We want to ensure that you and your family take the proper safety precautions by reminding you to let the professionals operate and service gas equipment. Please follow the safety quidance below:



Do not touch, service, or operate any South Jersey Gas owned equipment, including gas valves associated with your meter, which may be located inside or outside of your residence - no

matter how easy the procedure seems. Operating any South Jersey Gas equipment yourself could result in a serious safety hazard

Qualified South Jersey Gas technicians and contractors service and maintain our natural gas equipment such as pipes, valves, and meters to ensure your safety and service. It is our responsibility to service and maintain this equipment.



Gas lines and connections beyond the meter are owned by you, but we highly recommend that these lines **only be** serviced by a licensed plumber or

qualified contractor trained to perform work on natural gas lines, including your gas burning appliances.
